OPEN COORDINATION METHOD INCLUDES



- Fixing guidelines and timetables for achieving short, medium and long-term goals
- Establishing quantitative and qualitative indicators and benchmarks
- Translating European guidelines into BiH policies by setting specific measures and targets.
- Periodic monitoring of the progress achieving in order to put in place mutual learning processes.
