Universalistic Model

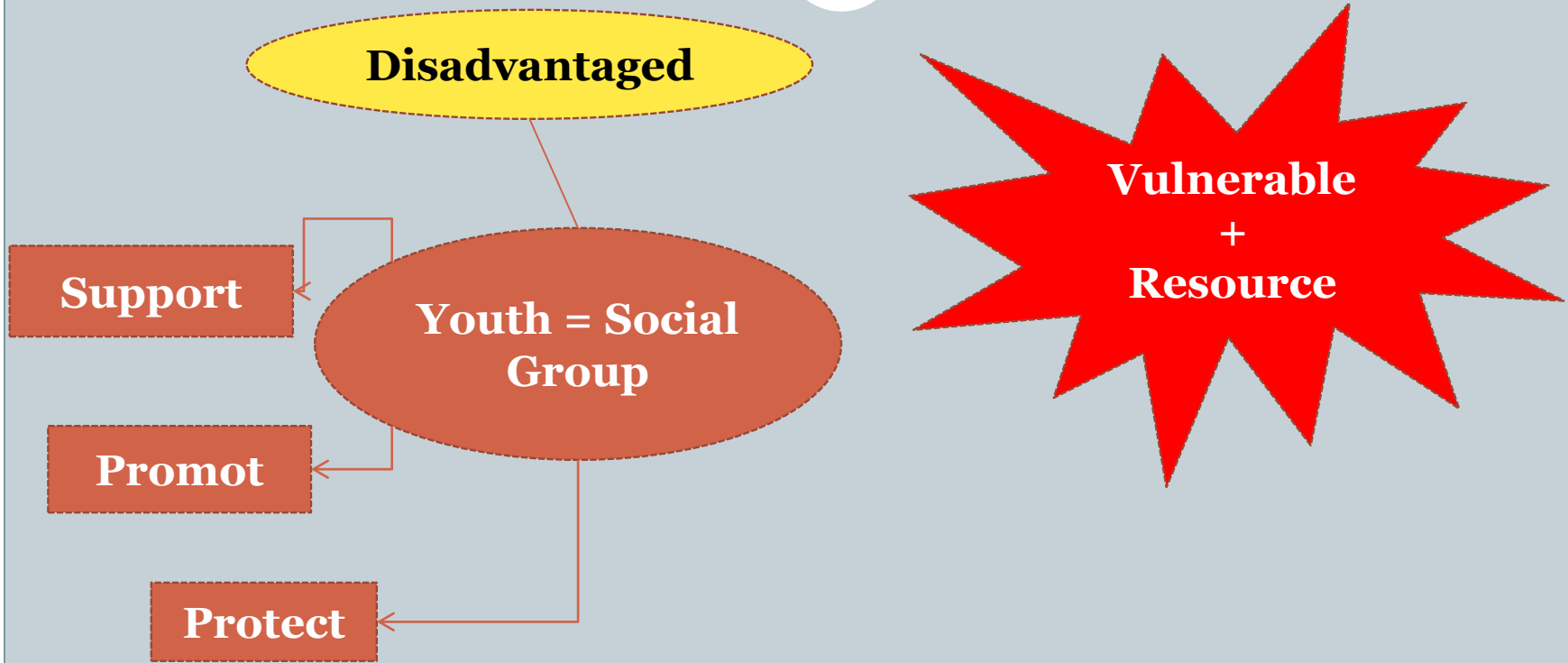


- targeting the **entire youth population**
- Youth is defined as up to the age of **25 years**.
- Young people are considered as **societal resources**

Autonomy and independence which support young people in living a successful youth life.



Protective Model



Social integration and prevention of social and participatory Problems.



Community based Model



State is traditionally reluctant to interfere in local youth work.
