- based on the principles of democracy, plurality, integrity, intergenerational solidarity, equality, non-discrimination and justice, multiculturalism, intercultural dialogue, volunteering, promoting a healthy lifestyle, respecting life and the environment, and the participation of non-governmental organisations in the management of public affairs.



Youth Policy aiming at...



- integration of youth in the economic, cultural and political life of the community
- Appropriate support mechanisms for developing youth work and operation of youth organisations

carried out in cooperation with autonomous and democratic representatives of youth organisations and professional and other organisations.
